# **Present Tense**


When the pronoun is third person singular, we need to add an s to a regular verb

Example:			(Q
He (stir)	stirs	the chocolate pudding.	

With verbs that end in **sh**, **ch**, **x**, **z**, or **ss**, we add **es** instead of **s**. The **es** sound makes the verb easier to pronounce.
